- It was very strange holding the AGM online so a big THANKYOU to those of you who attended, and the good news is that we got through the business in the 40 minutes allocated! Just hope that we do not have to repeat this next year!
- Covid restrictions past present and future sadly were the main feature of the last 12 months. Ben and Blake were very
 much thanked for their outstanding work to keep the coaching and use of the courts going through the times that we
 were allowed to be open.
- Reviewing the twelve months to 30th September, our highlight off court had been undoubtedly the very successful first Volleywood club evening run at Oswestry Cricket Club in November 2019 with over 100 of us crowded into the room.

- Our parent working group including Hattie Leslie-Miller junior rep, was re-elected en bloc, Emma Spelman took over the reins from Paula Jones as our Club welfare officer last summer, whilst Helen Shiel was reappointed as Treasurer. Many thanks to Emma and Helen for all their work through this very difficult year. I was re-elected Deputy Treasurer and Chairman for my fourth year in this position, and will again try to do my best for you. If anyone reading this would be interested in joining the working group and supporting its work, please let me know there's always room for more!
- For those interested in our finances, our accounts for 2019/20 show a surplus of £2567 which was credited to boost our general reserve to £6338, our resurfacing fund now stands at £3307, and our clubhouse fund donation now stands at 40k, thanks to Mike Markham's very generous donation of £20k.
- Regarding the clubhouse, Gavin Porritt of Design and Planning Associates Ltd based in Oswestry was appointed last Spring to assist us in taking the clubhouse project forward. We are getting to the stage of preparing a feasibility study to present to Oswestry Town Council later this year.

The latest LTA announcement is that there will be no club ballot for 2021.My advice to you is to register assuming you/your child is eligible as a LTA Member if you are not one already, so that you have the chance of a pair of tickets in 2022 when hopefully full crowds will be allowed back.
